

Lame Deer High School Graduation Requirements

- 4 credits of English language arts;
- 2 credits of mathematics;
- 2 credits of social studies;
- 2 credits of science;
- 1 credits of health enhancement, with ½ credit each year for two years;
- 1 credit of arts;
- 1 credit of vocational/technical education;
- 10 elective credits; 1 cr recommended - (Tribal Law; Cheyenne Lang, Beading, Tribal History)
- Total: 23 credits

ONLY STUDENTS WHO HAVE FULLY COMPLETED ALL REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN GRADUATION EXERCISES.

COLLEGE PREPARATORY REQUIREMENTS

The Montana University System requires that you complete the following college preparatory requirements:

- Four years of English.
- Three years of math, including Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. Students are encouraged to take a math class their senior year of high school.
- Three years of social studies, including one year of global studies, one year of American history and one year of government or another third-year course (i.e., economics, psychology, sociology).
- Two years of laboratory science. One must be earth science, biology, chemistry or physics. The second year may be one of those sciences or another approved college preparatory laboratory science.
- Two years chosen from the following: foreign/world language (preferably two years), computer science, visual and performing arts, or vocational education. ***Cheyenne Language = World Language**

State of Montana Graduation Requirements

A school district can establish its own requirements for graduation. The minimum graduation requirements are established by the Montana Board of Public Education and are found in ARM 10.55.905. A student has to complete a minimum of 20 credits in order to receive a Montana high school diploma with 13 credits in the following courses:

- 4 credits of English language arts;
- 2 credits of mathematics;
- 2 credits of social studies;
- 2 credits of science;
- 1 credits of health enhancement, with ½ credit each year for two years;
- 1 credit of arts;
- 1 credit of vocational/technical education;
